Thereafter, with the permission of the Hon'ble Dean Admin, the agenda items were deliberated upon and the following decision were taken unanimously:

Item No. 1.1: Confirmation of proceedings of IQAC meeting for academic year 2017-18.

Decision: The approved proceeding of the IQAC meeting for academic year 2017-18 was circulated to its members for information and comments, if any. No comments have been received. So this is confirmed.

Item No. 1.2: Status of admission in first year for academic year 2018-19.

Decision: Dean, academics presented the admission data for academic year 2018-19. It is observed that admission is decreasing on year-by-year basis. However, Dean (Acad.) informed to

members that it is a general trend among students to go abroad for study that is why student's strength is not only decreasing in our college but also in other colleges of whole Punjab.

Committee has asked the college to devise mechanisms to improve the admissions.

Item No. 1.3: Academic calendar for years 2018-19.

Decision: Dean, academics presented the academic calendar for year 2018-19, and same was implemented in tote.

Since Punjab Govt. leaves were followed by the college.

So the item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.4: Decreasing of seats in Electronics and Communication discipline.

Decision: College has implemented the decision of academic council.

So the item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.5: Start of three (AICTE/Non-AICTE) courses from session 2019-20.

Decision: College has implemented the decision of academic council.

So the item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.6: Renaming of course M.Sc. (Applied Chemistry) to M.Sc. (Chemistry).

Decision: College has implemented the decision of academic council.

So the item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.7: Table marking to evaluate external theory subject answer.

Since college has implemented the decision of academic council. So, item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.8: Education Quality Improvement through teaching of courses (Theory and Practical) using online platform during pandemic period.

Decision: College is using Google Classroom of GSuite platform to conduct classes (Theory as well as labs) using lucidly prepared power-point presentation (ppt) slides. To make the class lively, faculty is also making use of Animations, Videos and other teaching aids, which is available freely on the internet. IQAC has found this satisfactory and advised all the HoDs to keep the attendance record, lecture recording and other materials, and also ensure the sharing of lecture recordings with students.

Item No. 1.9: Formation of Department Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC) of different departments and their minutes of meetings.

Decision: Each department has formed its own Department Quality Assurance Committee (DQAC) and conducted regular meetings for enhancement of quality of academic activities in the respective departments. However, few suggestions have also been given regarding inclusion of extracurricular activities of students in the minutes of the meetings, and also conduct DQAC meetings frequently.

So this item is also confirmed.

Item No. 1.10: Education Quality Improvement through Propagation of Outcome Based Education (OBE)" as advocated by NBA.

Decision: Since all the governing bodies including AICTE are proponent of Outcome Based Education, so IQAC found it most appropriate to follow this pattern of education.

So this item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.11: One-week Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on 'Entrepreneurship development' by Mechanical Engineering department

A one-week Faculty Development Programme was organized by Mechanical Engineering Department during July, 11-24, 2018 wherein total 21 participates have attended the course.

This item is confirmed.

Item No. 1.12: Short-term course on 'Environmental Pollution and Control Techniques' by Chemical Engg Department

Decision: A short-term course on 'Environmental Pollution and Control Techniques' was conducted by chemical department wherein total number of participants were 79 from all over India. Committee suggested to conduct such course in Biotechnology department too.

So this item is also confirmed.

Item No. 1.13: Office communication through emails created in bcetgsp.ac.in domain.

Decision: Keeping in view of the current CORONA Virus pandemic college has created email accounts of all officials in bcetgsp.ac.in domain name.
