DECIDE THE ALLOTMENT OF CIVIL WORKS **ITEM No. 14.3** CONSTRUCTION OF INCOMPLETE BUILDINGS.

The construction of civil works was allotted to NBCC Limited in 1994 on turnkey basis by the Govt. of Punjab and accordingly the agreement was executed. As per the agreement, the NBCC Limited has constructed the following buildings:

- 1. Science Block
- Mechanical Block
- 3. Central Workshop
- 4. Community Health Centre
- Shopping Complex
- 6. Residential Complex (first phase)
- 7. Power House
- 8. Hostels (03 Boys, 01 Girls)
- 9. Boundary Wall

The construction work on the following buildings was started but due to the directions from the Govt. of Punjab, the execution of construction work was stopped in February 2001.

One Boys Hostel (Hostel No. 2)
 Chemical Block (partial)

3. Residential Complex (phase - II)

Now, we are in the receipt of directions from the Govt. of Punjab to decide the allotment of civil works for completion of incomplete buildings and to start the construction work on the balance buildings. Copy placed at Annexure - V from pages 3.7. to 3.8 As per clause No. 18.0 of the agreement duly executed with NBCC Limited on 08.6.1994, the alteration in the scope of work can be carried out. The clause is reproduced below:

....18.0 ALTERATION IN SCOPE OF WORK:

If at any time after acceptance of the tender the Employer shall decide to abandon or reduce the scope of the works for any reason whatsoever and hence not require the whole or any part of the works

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to be carried out. The Employer shall give notice in writing to that effect to the NBCC and the NBCC shall have no claim to any payment of compensation or otherwise whatsoever, on account of any profit or advance which he might have derived from the executing of the works in full but which he did not derive in consequence of the foreclosure of the whole or part of the work....

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ITEM No. 14.4 TO CONSIDER THE PAYMENT OF BORDER AREA ALLOWANCE TO THOSE WHO ARE NOT ALLOTTED RESIDENTIAL ACCOMMODATION IN THE CAMPUS.

Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Gurdaspur falls within the limits of 16 Kms. from the Border and as per the Punjab Govt. Rules the employees are entitled for the Border Area Allowance @ 5% of their Basic Pay. But the college is providing the rent free accommodation because as per rules license fee @ 5% of the basic pay is to be charged from all those who have been allotted Govt. accommodation and accordingly the college is neither paying to its employees the border area allowance @ 5% of the basic pay nor charging any license fee.

Some of the employees who have not been allotted residential accommodation as per their entitlement are claiming to make them payment of border area allowance. The matter was taken with the Principal of Shaheed Bhagat Singh College of Engineering & Technology, Ferozepur to know the practice followed in their college. As per the practice followed in that college, the employees who are not allotted Govt. accommodation in the college an additional HRA @ 5% of pay in lieu of rent free accommodation is admissible to the employees subject to the condition mentioned in letter No. 4/7/97-FPI/8781 dated Chandigarh 20th July 1998. Copies of the letters are placed at **Annexure** - VII at from pages 4.7. to 4.2

It is therefore, proposed that we may also be allowed to pay Border Area Allowance to those employees who are not allotted residential accommodation as per their entitlement.

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ITEM No. 14.5 TO CONSIDER THE WRITING OFF RS. 600/- PAID AS ADVANCE TO M/S CHIP EXICOM (I) PVT. LIMITED, MUMBAI FOR THE PURCHASE OF CHIP SPECIALS C.DS.

In compliance to instructions received vide memo No. 503 – 46 dated 19.7.1999 from Director, Technical Education & Industrial Training, Punjab for purchase of Chips Special CDs and accordingly supply order No. BCET/SPO/31/99/4466 dated 05.8.1999 along with advance of Rs. 1000/- in the shape of demand draft was placed with M/S Chip Exicom (I) Pvt. Limited, Mumbai. Copies are placed at Annexure – VIII from pages 49. to 53

The party had supplied the CDs costing Rs. 400/- only but did not complete the balance order. Despite the repeated reminders, the party has neither completed the order nor even supplied the alternative items i.e. CDs Digit Magazine nor any other special issue of Chip for the adjustment of advance amount. It is observed that this company is no longer in existence. The AG party which conducted the audit from 23rd August 2004 to 3rd September 2004 has raised the objections for non adjustment of advance of Rs. 600/- (copy placed at **Annexure - IX**) on page . 57

As we have spent almost equal amount of the balance advance on correspondence made with the party and there has been no response, it is therefore, proposed that Rs. 600/- may be written off as advance paid to the party.
