The following decisions were taken after detailed discussions:

ITEM No. 7.1 Confirmation of the minutes of sixth meeting of Finance Committee.

The action taken was noted.

ITEM No. 7.3 Budget Estimates for the year 2000-2001.

> The details of expenditure and the budget provisions for the year 1999-2000 were noted by the committee. It was also noted that the overall expenditure was within the budget provisions. estimates for the year 2000-2001 were considered and approved by the committee. A total budget of Rs.1519.00 lacs consisting of Rs. 382.70 lacs consisting of pay and allowances, TA and LTC, Medical

Reimbursement and contingencies was considered and approved by the committee, subject to the availability of funds (grant in aid plus revenue generated at the college). It was desired that the details about various receipts under different heads and their proposed expenditure may be mentioned separately.

ITEM No. 7.4

To consider the removal of anomalies in the pay scales of certain categories of employees working in the college.

After a detailed discussion, it was resolved to up-grade, the scales of following categories. However, no arrears will be paid to the employees upto the date of meeting of this Finance Committee.

i) Workshop Instructor:

Existing Scale Rs. 1640-2925 (pre-revised)
Changed to Rs. 1800-3200 (pre-revised)

ii) Photostat Machine Operator:

Existing Scale Rs. 810-1440 (pre-revised)
Changed to Rs. 830-1500 (pre-revised)

iii) Laboratory Attendant:

Existing Scale Rs. 750-1410 (pre-revised)
Changed to Rs. 800-1455 (pre-revised)

In the case of Library Assistant, and Laboratory Assistant/Skilled Assistant (Workshop), the up-gradation of scales was not agreed to as these categories were already getting scales as per Punjab Govt. notification. Hence, they will continue to draw the existing scales.

The committee noted the implementation of pay scales for the faculty as per the notification, issued by the Department of Finance, Govt. of Punjab.

ITEM No. 7.6 (A)

To follow the revised pay scales of teachers for the posts of Workshop Superintendent, System Analyst, Librarian and Director, Physical Education (D.P.E.).

The item was deferred as the revision of pay scales for the categories such as Workshop Superintendent, System Analyst, Workshop Foreman and Computer Programmer are under active consideration of the Department of Finance as the case for removal of anomalies has already been sent by the Department of Technical Education, Govt. of Punjab.
